

Our obligation to inform according to the battery law

In connection with the sale of batteries or accumulators or with the delivery of devices containing batteries or accumulators, we are obliged to inform you of the following in accordance with the Battery Act: Old batteries do not belong in household waste. End-users are legally obliged to return used batteries. You can return batteries after use to the seller or to the collection points provided for this purpose (e.g. in municipal collection points or at collection points in stores) free of charge.

Batteries containing harmful substances are marked with a crossed-out garbage sign and the chemical symbol (Cd, Hg or Pb) of the heavy metal decisive for classification as a pollutant:



Batteries containing harmful substances and the fact that batteries must not be disposed of with household waste but have to be disposed of properly are indicated by the garbage can symbol.

Pb = battery contains more than 0.004% percent by mass of lead

Cd = battery contains more than 0.002 percent by mass of cadmium

Hg = battery contains more than 0.0005 percent by mass of mercury
